#### 6.1. Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

##### 6.1.1. For non-emergency personnel

Emergency procedures : Not flammable. Keep away from sources of open fire. Follow fire safety rules. Explosion-proof. The flash point is higher than 84°C.  
Collect it with an adsorbent (sand, sawdust), the contaminated soil layers, remove and bury in a safe place away from water sources.

#### 6.3. Methods and material for containment and cleaning up

For containment : Collect spillage.  
Methods for cleaning up : Transport, equipment, product residues are disinfected with chlorinated lime, 10% solution of soda ash ; container with a 5% solution of caustic soda and is disposed of in accordance with the legislation. Do not reuse the container.  
Other information : Dispose of materials or solid residues at an authorized site.

### SECTION 7: Handling and storage

#### 7.1. Precautions for safe handling

Precautions for safe handling : It is necessary to use personal protective equipment: respirators, protective glasses, overalls and an apron made of dense fabric or material that repels water, rubber gloves and boots. After carrying out the work on the preparation of working solutions and processing, the overalls and equipment are disinfected. The overalls are soaked in a soap-soda solution for 6-8 hours, after which they are washed in a hot solution. Destruction of overalls and equipment is carried out at specially equipped sites. The washing water is poured into a special pit with a depth of at least 1m. All decontamination measures should be carried out with the use of personal protective equipment. Overall must be stored in a specially designated room. It is not allowed to leave overalls in the premises where pesticides are stored. It is forbidden to store clothes and personal protective equipment in residential or recreational premises.  
Hygiene measures : It is forbidden to eat, drink or smoke while working with the product. At the end of the work, it is necessary to change into clean clothes and thoroughly wash hands and face.

#### 7.2. Conditions for safe storage, including any incompatibilities

Technical measures : Maintain air gap between stacks/pallets.  
Storage conditions : Store in the original packaging label in a dry, cool, well-ventilated area, designed for the storage of pesticides. Keep out of the reach of children. Do not store together with food and animal feed. The optimal storage temperature is from 5 to 25 °C. Avoid direct sunlight.
